Dear Ms. Andreatta,

With the proviso that the judges of the Constitutional Court can naturally do so individually, I thank you for the impulse in the form of an e-mail / data message in the form of a letter dated 4.7.2025 concerning the protection of children's rights. I assume that not only because it is evident that you are guided by the best intentions, the judges of the Constitutional Court will familiarize themselves with the materials you have made available to them and will reflect them in their practice in an appropriate way. At the same time, however, none of them represents a "blank slate" in this respect and they have experience with the issue that is the subject of your interest. Unfortunately, even one that does not completely coincide with your view; As judges, they must always consider broader circumstances, or rather, part of their job is all too often the need to seek a fair balance between various interests, or in the worst case, completely contradictory. This does not necessarily mean that any of them would be manifestly illegitimate. In the case of disputes on which you concentrate, this is indeed an unenviable task, because they usually do not have, or cannot have, a really good solution with which all the participants could internally identify.

However, this does not naturally mean that any of the judges of the Constitutional Court would give up on their honest search for it in advance.

I would venture to assume that you welcomed the establishment of the position of the Children's Ombudsman, who I think would appreciate the knowledge you have gathered so far as a welcome contribution to the launch of your activities. (I do not suppose that you might miss the fact that in the initial period his role is temporarily entrusted to a deputy of the Public Defender of Rights).
